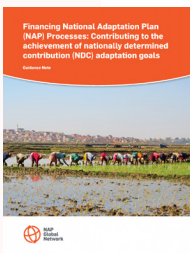

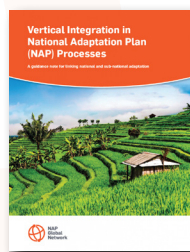

Financing is needed throughout the entire NAP process to enable its potential to be reached—from its initiation to the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of prioritized adaptation actions. Towards Gender-Responsive NAP Processes: Progress and Recommendations for the Way Forward

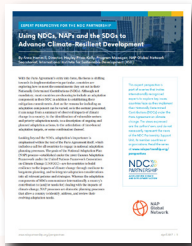
Synthesis Report, 2017-18

This report presents an analysis of progress on integrating gender considerations in NAP processes. It is based on a review of completed NAP documents available on NAP Central at the end of January 2018, as well as data collected directly from country NAP teams. Based on this analysis, we draw out lessons learned to date and identify common themes across countries.



Strengthening Gender Considerations in Kiribati's NAP Process

This scoping study explored options for strengthening gender considerations in Kiribati's National Adaptation Plan (NAP) process with a focus on its NAP document, the Joint Implementation Plan on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Management (KJIP). To explore options for strengthening gender considerations in the revision of the KJIP, the NAP Global Network collaborated with the Office of the President to hold stakeholder consultations in the capital, South Tarawa, in August 2017.



Using NDCs, NAPs and the SDGs to Advance Climate-Resilient Development

This report, co-written with the NDC Partnership, discusses how the NAP process can provide an operational bridge between countries' Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) adaptation components and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). It is part of a series convened by the NDC Partnership exploring key issues countries face as they implement their NDCs under the Paris Agreement on climate change.

COUNTRY NAP PROCESS POSTERS



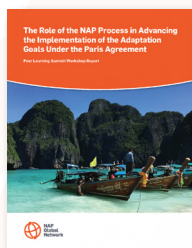
